## **Supporting Science**



Thanks to a donation from the Franklin Community Foundation, the science classrooms received a goggle sanitation cabinet. A goggle sanitation cabinet is a standard piece of lab equipment that uses a high-powered UV lamp to generate ultraviolet light to kill germs on goggles. The sanitation cabinet you funded has an express setting, allowing for the goggles to be sanitized in 5-15 minutes; Giving back-to-back labs/classes access to clean goggles. This cabinet is going to provide clean goggles to all of our students.

The Franklin Community Foundation has also supported our science students with ventures out into our community! The 9th grade Living Environment class went on a field trip to animal adventure in October of 2021. Students learned about various animals, how they live in their environments, and about ways that we (as a society) can support them.

The Franklin Community Foundation paid for each of these students to feed the four Reticulated Giraffes. Our students were able to go up to the giraffes in small groups and feed them carrots. The delight on their faces when the long black tongue wrapped around the carrots (and sometimes their fingers) was beautiful. To this day, I hear them talking about the experience.

One reluctant student who didn't want to go on the field trip. She said that she hated animals and she knew she wasn't going to have a good time. When one of the giraffes took a carrot from her, the smile didn't go away for the rest of the day. On the bus ride home, she shared that it was one of the best experiences she's ever had. The Community Foundation did that.



Additionally, the staff commented on how well behaved and polite our students were. They said they often have issues with school groups not following directions with the giraffe exhibit. Not our students! They listened to everything asked of them, and left a huge impression! Months later when I went back to Animal Adventure to see their Christmas Lights display, the same staff remembered me and said that they'd love to have our students back. It was a great feeling to know that Franklin had left such an impression on them.
