Drones Come to Franklin

This school year introduced some of the students to drones through a program called Drone Legends. This program provided students with hands-on experience flying and maintaining drones, including troubleshooting with connections and flight patterns. They learned how drones are being used in the real -world. Some of these experiences included fighting forest fires using "dragons eggs", finding people missing in hurricane ravaged areas and keeping people safe from sharks as they are used by lifequards. The drones unit provided opportunities for students to collaborate with each other, problem solve and engage with the drones using both the remote and computer coding. Currently, fifth and sixth grade students have been able to use drones. In the spring when the weather becomes nicer, the 7th and 8th graders will learn to use drones.
